



New state chair to speak at our monthly meeting on January 12

Our monthly meeting will be held on Thursday Jan. 12, at the Gloucester





The featured speaker will be the newly elected chair of the Massachusetts Democratic Party, Gus Bickford.

Bickford, who worked for John Kerry and Elizabeth Warren, is an expert in survey research and campaigns that reach specific groups of voters, was elected to lead the party for the next four years. "We begin now for 2018," Bickford said after his election. Bickford, 53, was also involved in the "No on 2" campaign, which successfully defeated Question 2, a ballot initiative that sought to expand access to charter schools.

Bickford has said that his highest priority is to prepare the party to take on Gov. Baker in 2018.

The meeting begins with a social hour at 7 and the program begins promptly at 7:30.
